## ACCOUNTING CONCENTRATION / BBA

ALL CONCENTRATION INFORMATION EFFECTIVE FOR STUDENTS ADMITTED 1/2005 OR THEREAFTER. REVISED 4/2007

The suggested Accounting concentration program presumes that 62 hours of pre-admission requirements and free electives have been earned. Use worksheets and check with the Advisement Center if necessary to calculate earned pre-admission hours. While all courses are required, there are a number of alternative sequences that are equally satisfactory. Use the worksheet and the catalog to check for prerequisites.

A concentration in Accounting requires 18 accounting credit hours in addition to MGMT 202 and 303. The required courses are MGMT 340, 341, 343, 346, 443 and 449. Courses in bold letters are those for the 18-hour Accounting concentration.

### REQUIRED ACCOUNTING COURSES

MGMT 202: Principles of Financial Accounting (preadmission requirement)

MGMT 303: Managerial Accounting\*

MGMT 340: Financial Accounting I\*

MGMT 346: Cost Accounting (prerequisite: MGMT 303)

\*May be taken concurrently

After MGMT 340 has been completed (with a grade of C- or better), students must complete the courses listed below. Except where noted, they may be completed in either order:

MGMT 341: Financial Accounting II

(prerequisite: MGMT 340, must take in residence at Anderson)

MGMT 343: Income Tax Accounting II

After MGMT 341 has been completed (with a grade of C- or better), students must complete:

MGMT 443: Auditing

(pre- or co-requisite: MGMT 341)

After MGMT 346 has been completed (with a grade of C- or better), or concurrently, students must complete:

MGMT 449 Accounting Information Systems

### ACCOUNTING ELECTIVES

In addition to the above required courses, students may wish to take any (or all) of the following Accounting area elective courses. These courses may be used as Free Elective courses:

MGMT 342: Income Tax Accounting I

MGMT 444: Accounting for Not-for-Profit Organizations (prerequisite: MGMT 341\*)

MGMT 348: Legal Concepts for Accountants (prerequisites: MGMT 310 & MGMT 340)
